LPG Do's



Always keep the cylinder in upright position with valve on top.



Always install the cylinder at ground level, keeping the LPG appliance at a higher level.



Ensure there is adequate ventilation at floor level and at top level.



Keep the area clean. Restrict entry to authorized persons only.



Shout and raise alarm/siren in case of unsafe conditions



In case of leakage, stop all operations, close all isolation valves, put the safety cap and take the cylinder to an open space.



Use D.C.P type fire extinguishers in case of fire.



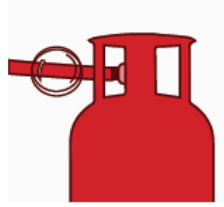
Call Fire Brigade, Aegis Puregas Team, if leakage is not controlled..



LPG Dont's



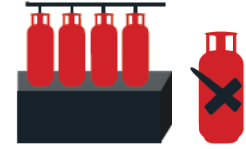
Don't keep the cylinder exposed to sun, rain, dust and heat



Don't forget to check the cylinder for any leakage from 'O' ring and valve before connecting.



Don't forget to turn off the valve when cylinder is not in use.



Don't keep unconnected cylinders.



Don't keep any extra material in the LPG shed.



Don't allow battery operated instruments, any non-flame proof electrical items like cameras, phones etc. inside the LPG shed



No smoking inside & around the LPG shed or area.



No naked flame anywhere inside & around the LPG shed or area.
